SACRAMENTS INFORMATION | INFORMACIÓN
PARA LOS SACRAMENTOS

Baptism: You must be a registered member of the parish for at least 6 months. Register your child in the parish office before attending the class, bring birth certificate and \$50 donation per couple or person. **Godparents must be married by the Church and must take baptismal preparation at the parish where they are registered. If for some reason they can't take class at their parish they need to notify the parish office. If they are single, the sponsor must be over 18 years of age and have received Confirmation and First Communion**

Bautizos: Deben estar registrados en la parroquia por lo menos 6 meses. Registrar a su niño/a en la oficina antes de asistir a las clases, traer acta de nacimiento y la donación de \$50. **Los padrinos deben ser casados por la Iglesia y deberán tomar platicas en la parroquia donde estén registrados. Si son solteros, el padrino o madrina debe ser mayor de 18 años y haber recibido la Confirmación y Primera Comunión.** Para mas información, sobre las fechas favor de llamar a la oficina Parroquial.

Marriage: Please contact the parish office at least six months in advance so that we can work with you to prepare for your wedding. Either the bride or groom need to be a registered member of the parish.

Matrimonios: Favor de llamar a la oficina parroquial, por lo menos 6 meses antes del matrimonio para su preparación. Los novios deben ser miembros registrados de la parroquia por lo menos 6 meses antes de solicitar información.

What is 40 Days for Life?

It is a 40-day campaign that aims to end abortion locally through **prayer & fasting**, **peaceful hourly vigils**, and **community outreach**. Although the U.S. Supreme Court concluded in *Dobbs v. Jackson* that the Constitution has no provision for abortion, elective abortions are still being conducted in Utah.

Why 40 Days?

Throughout Biblical history, God has used 40-day periods to *transform* individuals, communities, and nations...

- Noah was transformed by 40 days of rain
- Moses was transformed by 40 days on Mount Sinai
- David was transformed by Goliath's 40 day challenge

How can I get involved?

Prayer & Fasting: Ask for 40 Days Devotional Booklets (E-mail Contact below).

Peaceful Vigils: Sign-up for one hour a week on the website (below) to pray with a buddy for the end of abortion. We value your time and effort, so if you can't commit weekly, just show up when you can (with a buddy).
